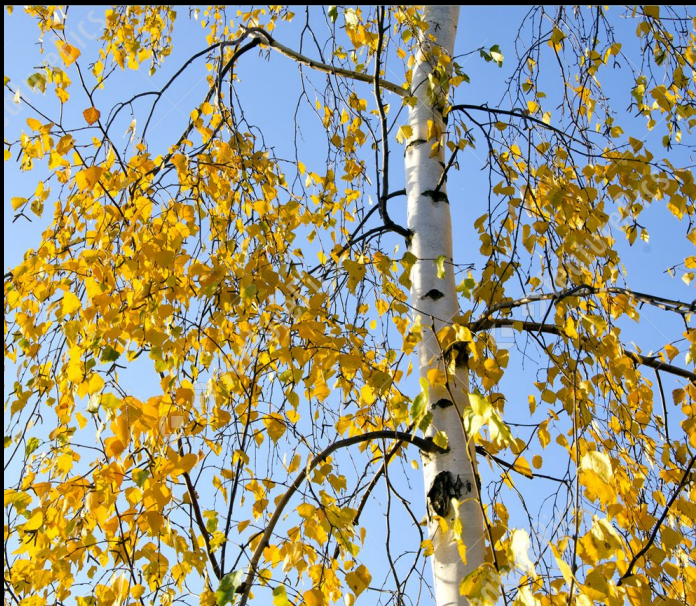

Benefit: Attracts butterfly larvae and squirrels. Can be tapped to collect sap like Maple sap, butternut sap can be reduced through boiling to produce sweet syrup. Fruit is edible with sweet oily taste, do not eat if allergic to nuts and the husk of the fruit and bark can be used to make a yellow dye.

Benefit: Attracts various wildlife squirrels, chipmunks, birds and butterflies. Nuts are edible, can be eaten raw or placed in baked goods provided you are not allergic to nuts.

Wrapping them in maple leaves preserves them longer. Trees grow better and produce better quality fruit if grown with foxglove and wallflowers.

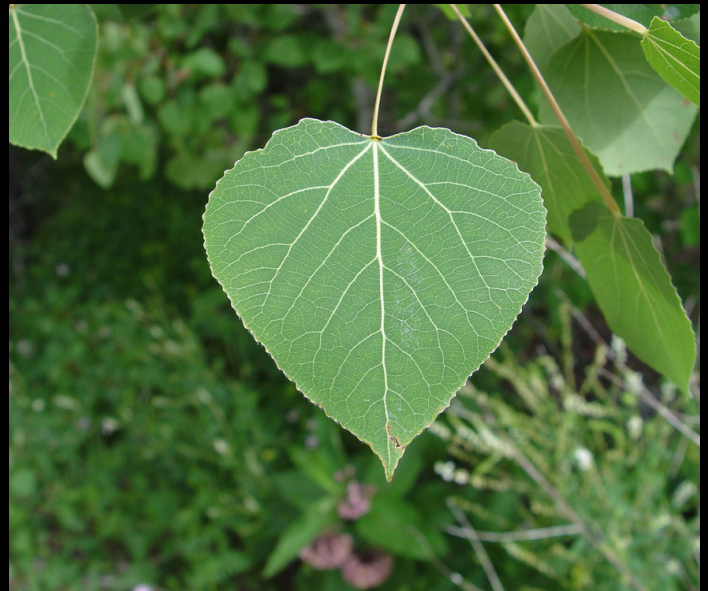

Good for shrub borders, open wood land gardens or native plant areas.

resistant.

Benefit: Excellent source of food for many wildlife species including deer, turkeys, squirrels, rabbits, and raccoons, also offers roosting and nesting sites for numerous species of birds. Wood used for barrels, hardwood flooring and fence posts.

Growth Rate: Moderate to fast

Type: Deciduous Tree

Benefit: Attracts squirrels, chipmunks and deer as the nut is a food source for them, also attracts songbirds, ground birds and wild turkey. The wood is used for furniture, floors and posts.

Benefit: Attracts squirrels, deer, turkeys, and birds. Is a medium shade tree for lawns, streets or parks.

Type: Coniferous Tree

Benefit: Attracts small mammals like porcupines, squirrels and birds. Is valuable for wildlife habitat, preferred by white tail deer for both shelter and food. Wood is used for fences, posts, shingles, canoes and outdoor furniture.

Benefit: Bees are important pollinators of winterberry flowers. Wildlife (mammals and more than 48 species of birds) also use this shrub for cover and nesting, and the berries serve as a food source for birds during the fall and winter.

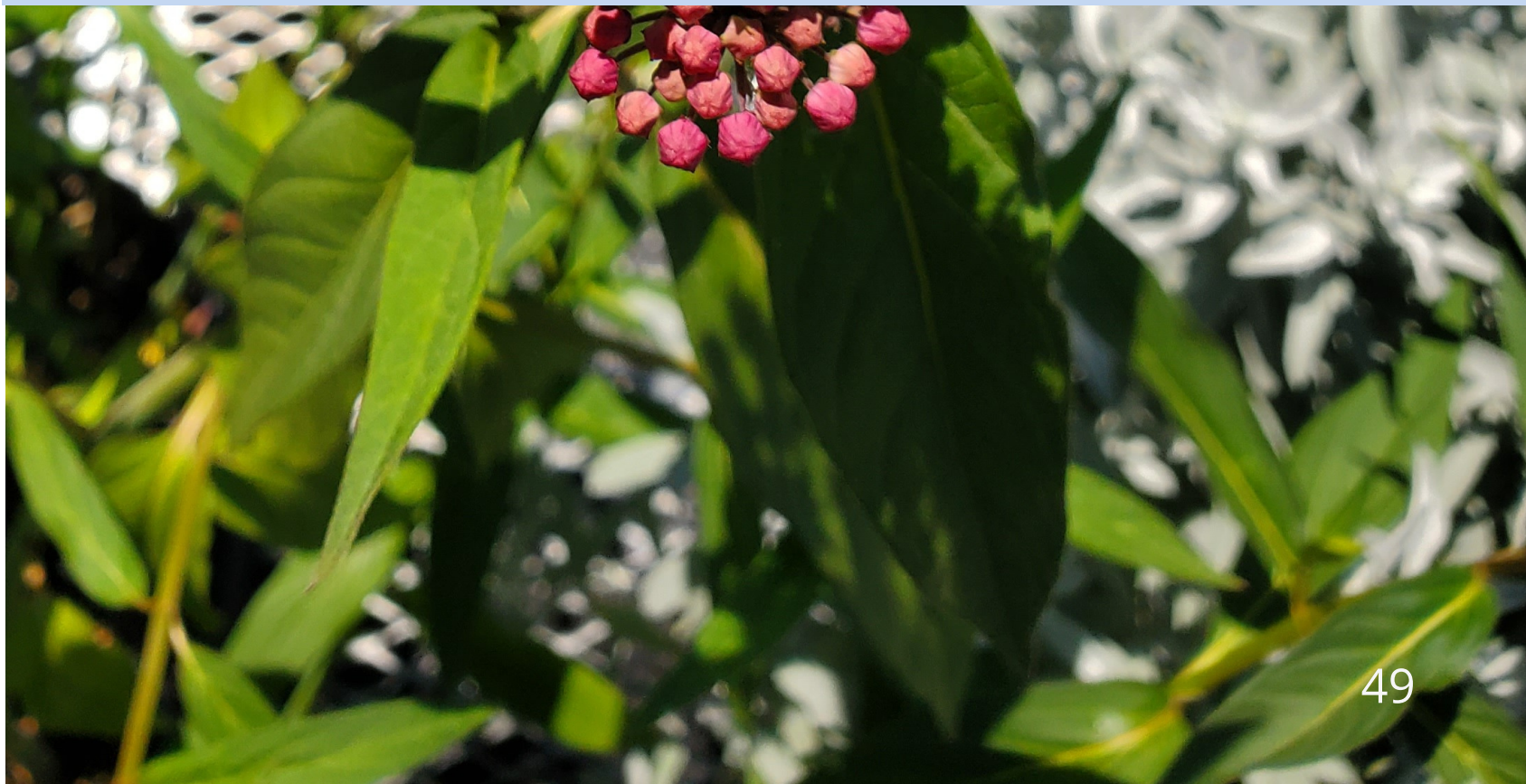

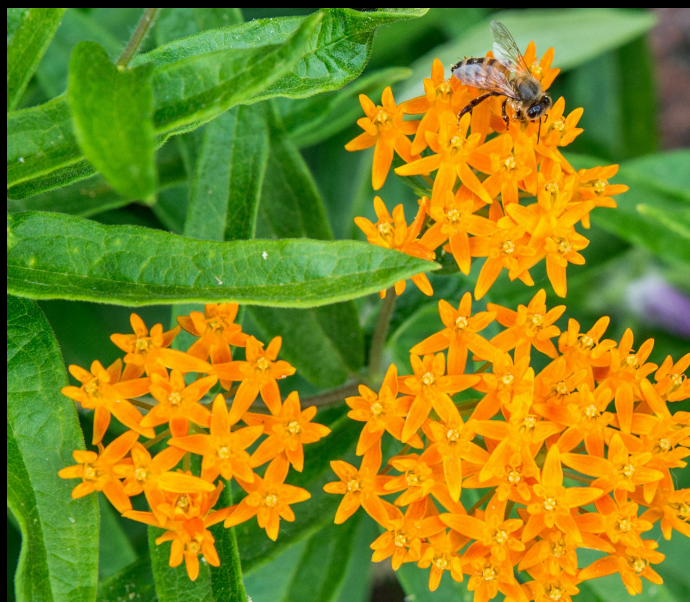
